

Child Nutrition

The Child Nutrition Department of Amherst County Public Schools strives to provide healthy meals for all of our students each day. We employ 44 staff members who have provided 429,367 lunches and 247,889 breakfasts during the 16-17 school year. About half of our students qualify for free or reduced price meals. We provide many programs throughout the school year and summer with the goal of meeting the nutritional needs of the students that we serve. We have taken an active role to increase breakfast participation. At two of our Elementary schools, MHES and CES, we provide free breakfast in the classroom to all of the students. At all of our other schools we have eliminated the reduced category at breakfast. All students who qualify for either free or reduced price meals can receive a free breakfast. We have also implemented alternate breakfast models at two other schools, Amelon and AMS, in order to boost breakfast participation. Also at MHES we have the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable grant program. Students at MHES receive a daily fresh fruit or vegetable snack through this program.

Secondary students that participate in afterschool activities are eligible to receive a free afterschool snack. We served 26,873 free afterschool snacks to our students last year who were participating in an afterschool activity. Each summer we serve meals to a variety of programs that are housed in schools throughout Amherst County. Last summer we provided 7,920 free breakfasts and 8,056 free lunches to students participating in summer programs. We strive to meet the needs of our students in whatever capacity that we can serve them and we are committed to providing healthy meals/snacks that our students enjoy.

The Child Nutrition Budget is self-sustaining, receiving no county funds.
