Amherst County Public Schools continue to provide extended learning opportunities for all students during the time that schools are closed. All learning opportunities will be extended through April 10th, 2020. Beginning on April 20th, you will receive updated information about how learning opportunities will proceed for students through the remainder of the school year. These are not graded assignments; they do not have to be turned in and nothing needs to be printed. For high school students, these resources are not used to fulfill any graduation requirements.
