I. Who is Eligible?

- A. Children who are 4 years old by September 30th and live in Amherst County
- B. Children who may need extra support before entering kindergarten
- C. Consideration for non-resident students based on available slots

II. What Does the Program Cost?

A. Free- No cost to parents

III. Process for Enrollment

- A. Complete application
- B. Provide the following:
 - Household income in the form of: tax form, pay stub, verification of SNAP (food stamps), TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families), and/ or SSI (Supplemental Security Income)
 - 2. Child's age (birth certificate-<u>upon acceptance</u> into the program)
 - 3. Physical examination (*upon acceptance* into the program)
 - 4. Up-to-date immunization record (*upon acceptance* into the program)
 - 5. Annual Registration/Emergency Form (*upon acceptance* into the program)
 - 6. Completed Free & Reduced Price Meals Application (*upon acceptance* into the program)

IV. How Will the Program Benefit the Children?

- A. Children will work on the following skills:
 - 1. Social Skills
 - 2. Self-help skills
 - 3. Language development skills
 - 4. Pre-reading, writing skills, and mathematics
 - 5. Physical skills
- B. May include medical and dental screenings
- C. Speech and language skills
- D. Breakfast, lunch, and snack
- E. Transportation provided

V. How Will the Program Benefit the Parents & How Can Parents Be Involved?

- A. Enrollment of the child in a full day quality preschool program
- B. Participation in a Family Involvement Plan which may include:
 - 1. Parent Conferences
 - 2. Participation in classroom activities, field trips
 - 3. Parent Workshop/s
 - 4. Access to resources and materials to support your child's development

- 5. Information/assistance to parents (community resources, opportunities to enroll in adult education programs, etc.)
- 6. Home visits
- VI. Reasons for Termination from the Program
 - A. Consecutive unexcused absences
 - B. Continuous poor attendance
 - C. Request from parents to withdraw child from program
 - D. Family moves out of Amherst County
