## CHILD FIND STATEMENT

Amherst County Public Schools provides for a free and appropriate public education for all children with disabilities in a variety of specially designed programs. Special Education and related services are available for persons, ages 2-21 inclusive, who have disabilities in the following areas: autism, deaf-blindness, developmental delay, deafness, hearing impairment, intellectual disabilities, multiple disabilities, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, emotional disability, specific learning disability, speech or language impairment, traumatic brain injury, and visual impairment. Programs for preschool-aged children with disabilities are also available.
